

COVID-19 AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

We're so glad to be able to welcome you back through our gates and are closely monitoring the current COVID-19 situation. As of Monday, July 6, we are operating under the Stage Queensland Industry Plan for Live Performance Venues / Theatres which has, thankfully, allowed us to operate with some changes to our daily operations. Here's what you'll need to know about visiting our audition venues!

BOOKING YOUR AUDITION

With our new ticketing service and website, your audition registration will work similarly to purchasing a general admission ticket with us. This is to ensure that our COVID tracking can be integrated into the process as seamlessly as possible.

Auditions will only be available online or by direct request through email.

Audition slots have been released in small numbers, to ensure that social distancing between auditionees can be maintained. This may mean that, if full, new slots may not be opened.

If you are having difficulties registering for your desired time, please contact the office to discuss availability.

YOUR ARRIVAL & AUDITION

Please do not attend if you have been feeling under the weather, experienced flu-like symptoms or have travelled overseas in the last two weeks. If you find you are unable to attend due to sudden illness, please let us know via email as soon as possible.

We ask that you arrive no earlier than 15 minutes prior to your audition, and do not loiter outside the venue. Please bring a pen with you to reduce the spread of germs. If you do forget on the day, the stage management team will be able to provide you with freshly sanitised stationery.

Upon your arrival to the audition venue, Brisbane Arts Theatre staff and volunteers will greet you with a pre-packaged audition pack, hand sanitiser and a temperature check. They will direct you to a specific area where you can then fill out your paperwork. A new COVID specific form is contained in this pack, so please ensure that all documents included are filled out as this will directly influence your ability to audition on the day.

We understand that some of the restrictions in place can be frustrating and confusing, but your health and safety is our biggest concern in these strange times.
